DOCUMENT 5: CANDIDATE PHOTO REQUIREMENTS

The candidature file must contain the following color photos in high resolution electronic format and which must be compliant with the photo requirements detailed below:

- 1x recent color portrait photo of the candidate (from head to chest) with a plain background;
- 4x action color photos of the candidate practicing their sport (two in landscape format and two in portrait format);

These photos will be used to present the candidate in the Election Manual and other promotional items related to the election. Therefore, they need to be both of good quality and in very high resolution (4,000x6,000 pixels @ 300 dpi).

Action Photo Requirements

The action shots must comply with the Bye-law to Rule 50 of the Olympic Charter. To ensure that the action shot photos are Rule 50-compliant, the IOC recommends that the photo is one taken during past Olympic Games.

Paragraph 1 of the Bye-law to Rule 50 states: "No form of publicity or propaganda, commercial or otherwise, may appear on persons, on sportswear, accessories or, more generally, on any article of clothing or equipment whatsoever worn or used by all competitors, team officials, other team personnel and all other participants in the Olympic Games, except for the identification - as defined in paragraph 8 below - of the manufacturer of the article or equipment concerned, provided that such identification shall not be marked conspicuously for advertising purposes."

According to paragraph 8 of the Bye-law, "the word 'identification' means the normal display of the name, designation, trademark, logo or any other distinctive sign of the manufacturer of the item, appearing not more than once per item."

Further details on Rule 50 can be found on NOCnet in the "Guidelines re 9. filQloA_ugthorised Identifications". Portrait photo requirements

The photo should be taken with a plain background and in a well-lit indoor setting. The photo should include at least the head and shoulders of the candidate. Ensure that the visible clothing complies with the Bye-law to Rule 50 of the Olympic Charter.
